

Results of Birling Parish Council Highways Improvement Consultation

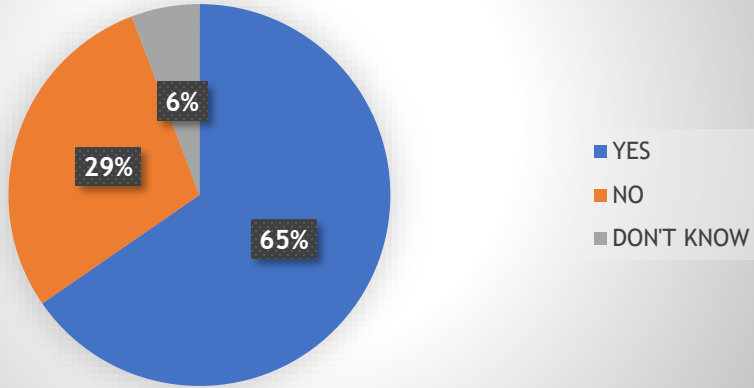
The parish council would like to thank everyone that responded to the questionnaire.

A total of 52 responses were received from residents.

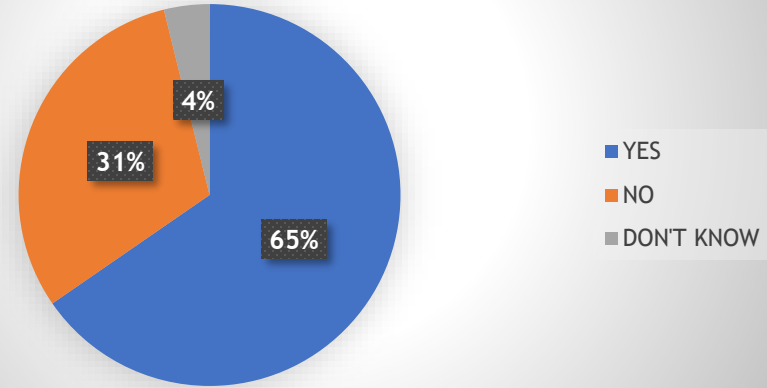

All of the ideas suggested are subject to affordability.

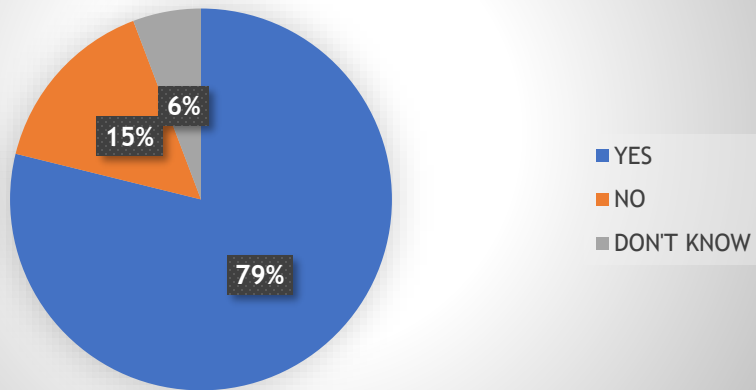
Priority signage on buildouts through Ryarsh and Birling



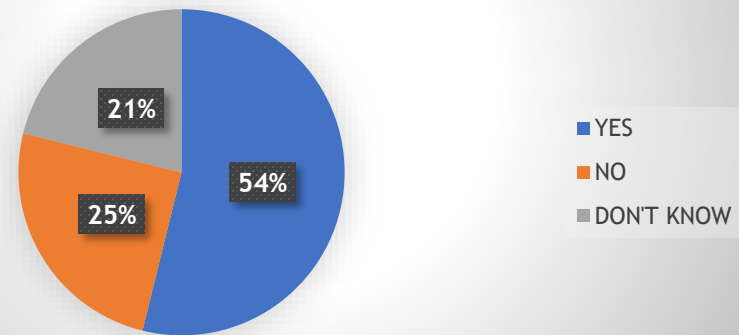
Removal of build out at Bull Road to allow installation of a table top



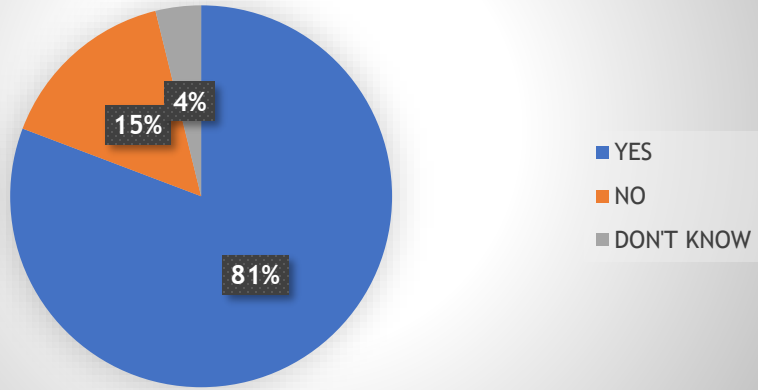
Upgrade speed indicator sign and install new at Snodland Road



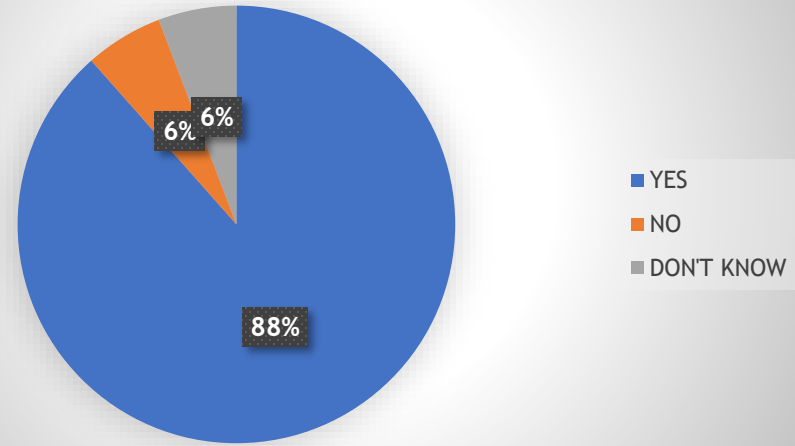
Install 30mph roundels on carriageway and 30mph repeater signs



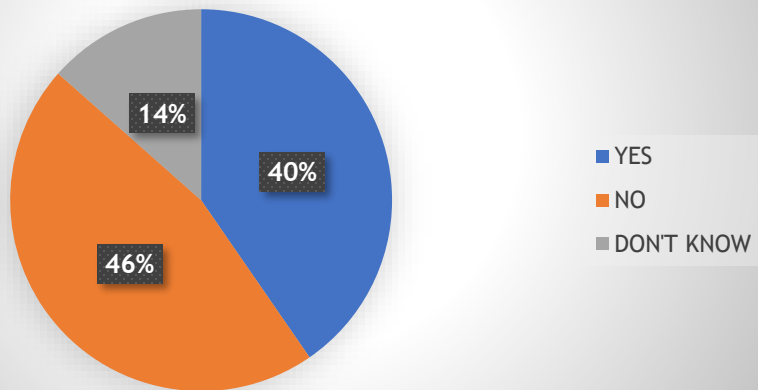
Introduce a 20mph limit to the parish



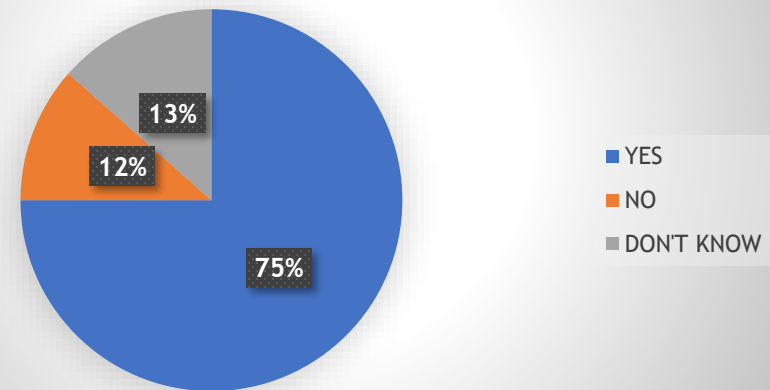
Reduce 60mph limits to 40mph



Install double yellow lines at Bull Road t-junction



Install safety signs on narrow roads



Further considerations that have arisen from the consultation:

- ▶ Additional weight limit signage where appears to be missing
- ▶ Pavement widths generally
- ▶ Pavement improvements, particularly Bull Road/ Birling road
- ▶ Cycle lanes in accordance with latest Government guidance
- ▶ Restrictions on vehicles entering the private layby on Bull Road
- ▶ Bins, vegetation and vehicles obstructing footways
- ▶ Fixed speed camera installation
- ▶ Additional locations for speed humps to slow traffic
- ▶ Comments generally about school parents inconsiderate parking, speeding and the build out restrictions in Ryarsh
