
Results of Birling Parish Council Highways Improvement Consultation


The parish council would like to thank everyone that responded to the questionnaire.


A total of 52 responses were received from residents.




All of the ideas suggested are subject to affordability.



















Further considerations that have arisen from the consultation:

- Additional weight limit signage where appears to be missing
- Pavement widths generally
- Pavement improvements, particularly Bull Road/ Birling road
- Cycle lanes in accordance with latest Government guidance
- Restrictions on vehicles entering the private layby on Bull Road
- Bins, vegetation and vehicles obstructing footways
- Fixed speed camera installation
- Additional locations for speed humps to slow traffic
- Comments generally about school parents inconsiderate parking, speeding and the build out restrictions in Ryarsh
