 It was noted that soft measures are being investigated to reduce speeds, this will help reduce the speed for a future attempt at a 20mph zone application.

The general view appears to show a wish to retain the Strategic gap between East and West Malling.

The reason for the delayed public release of the Call for Sites information is unknown.

The reference number for Birling Parish Council does not refer to the consultee response and the Clerk will raise this with TMBC. Councillors were referred to the CPRE paper on Green Belt policy.
